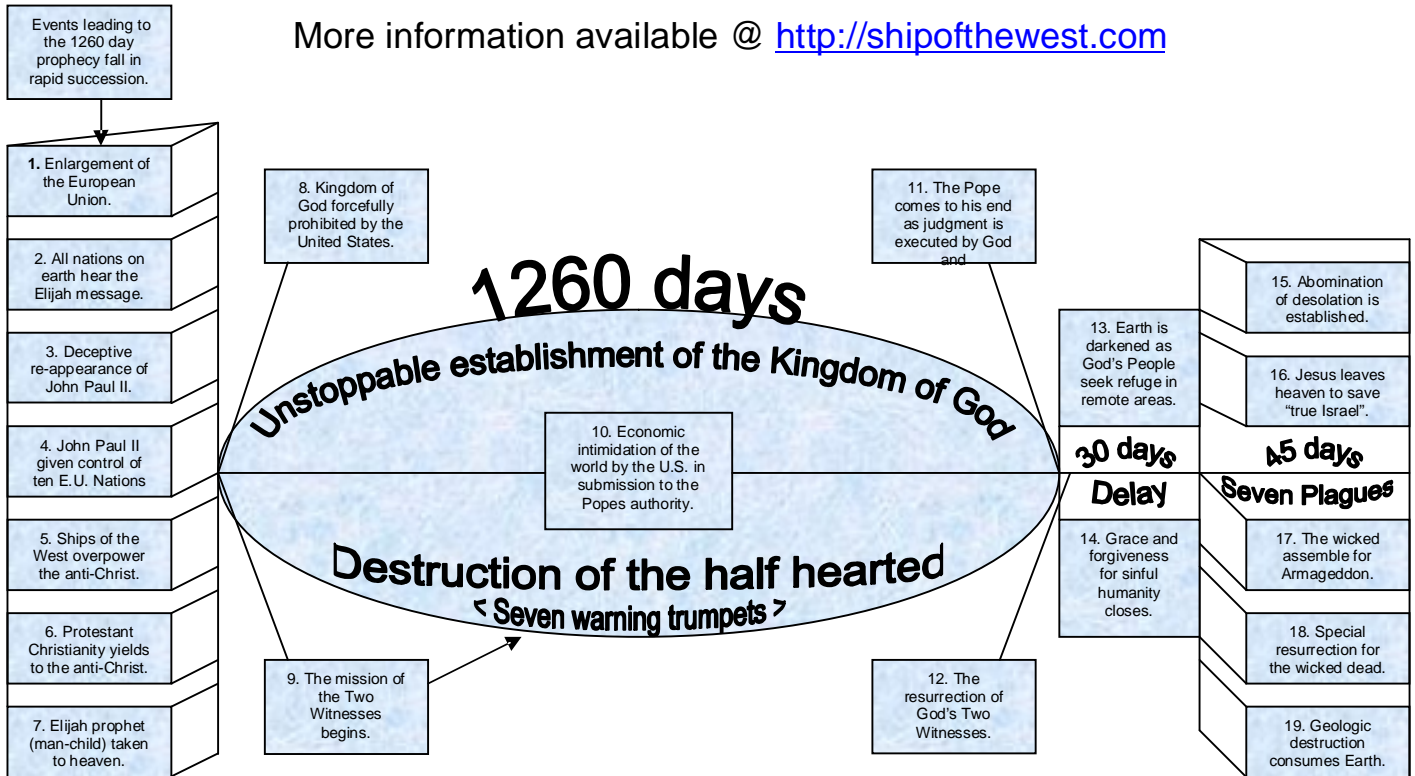


# The "Last days" Prophetic sequencing map

"The love of most will grow cold, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved" (Matthew 24:12-13).



- Ø It will take 1260 days (3 ½ years) to saturate the world with God's warning message despite great persecution by the "Beast" – "And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come" (Matthew 24:14). "And they that understand among the people shall instruct many: yet they shall fall by the sword, and by flame, by captivity, and by spoil, many days. (Daniel 11:33). The saints will be handed over to him for a time, times and half a time." (Daniel 7:25).
- Ø 30 days of delay before the "Seven Last Plagues" fall upon the persecutors of God's people. Sinners had evidence, yet neglected spiritual preparation to meet God – "Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision! For the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision. The sun and moon will be darkened, and the stars no longer shine. The LORD will roar from Zion and thunder from Jerusalem; the earth and the sky will tremble. But the LORD will be a refuge for his people, a stronghold for the people of Israel" (Joel 3:13-16).
- Ø 45 days after the "Abomination of Desolation" God bestows a great blessing upon the remainder of His people – "Blessed is the one who waits for and reaches the end of the 1,335 days" (Daniel 12:11-12).

**Note:** The expansion of the European Union to include 10 new nations on May 1, 2004, marks our generation as the last to dwell upon this earth for 1000 years. A prophetic dream was given by God 2500 years ago, detailing the progression of earthly governments, beginning with kingdom of Babylon and ending at the time of the Enlargement of the European Union. (The ten toes) "And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people" (Daniel 2:44). Shortly after Europe unites, God's Everlasting Kingdom will arise and shall display its sovereignty over earthly governments, sweeping them away forever. "The iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold... became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them" (Daniel 2:35).
